## Anna Pinot Noir

Yamhill-Carlton AVA Willamette Valley, Oregon

### *Vintage:*

After a relatively mild winter, 2020 greeted us with unseasonably warm spring temperatures early on, followed by rain and cooler temperatures in May and June. Subsequently, both estate vineyards were hit with heavy rainstorms while the vines were flowering, causing uneven fruit set and overall low yields. July and August were slightly warmer and drier than average, so disease pressure was fortunately very low this vintage. Altogether, bud break occurred just slightly earlier than average and the rest of the growing season kept up at the same pace; until we finally brought in our first fruit on September 7th for our Rosé of Pinot Noir.

### *Tasting Notes:*

This small, three-barrel cuvée, named in honor of proprietor Giorgio Furioso's mother, is meant to represent the more lush and savory side of our Trovato Vineyard in Yamhill-Carlton. The nose offers enchanting notes of raspberry, strawberry, mint and wet stone, but its time in new oak also brings woody aromas of sandalwood and dried cedar. Darker fruited in the mouth, the palate gives black fruits, sanguine notes, and blood orange on the finish.

Case Production: 75 cases

Production: 100% destemmed, unfinned and unfiltered

Barrel regimen: 10 months in 33% new French oak, 33% 1 year old barrels, 33% neutral

ABV: 13.7%

### **Cellaring:**

Two to five years post vintage. 2022 - 2025
