***Vintage:***

2021 was a vintage for the books. We saw multiple record breaking heatwaves throughout the valley but luckily, the fruit was not greatly affected from this and continued to ripen at a normal pace with little sign of water stress on our dry farmed vineyards.

The fruit set was above average and the weather leading up to picking time was ideal. The fruit quality was pristine, thanks to the mostly dry conditions. The 2021 vintage will be one to drink in its youth – showing off lusher mouthfeels and riper fruit.

***Tasting Notes:***

The 2021 vintage gave us a long, warmer than average summer - resulting in exceedingly friendly, ripe fruited Pinot Noirs. Though still young, the 2021 Pietro already offers an aromatic nose and textured palate to match. While there is an abundance of ripe black fruit notes, there are also plenty of leaner herbaceous and mineral-tinged notes to create balance. The finish brings more juiciness alongside sweet tannins...a wine that promises to please universally.
