Vintage:

2021 was a vintage for the books. We saw multiple record breaking heatwaves throughout the valley but luckily, the fruit was not greatly affected from this and continued to ripen at a normal pace with little sign of water stress on our dry farmed vineyards.

The fruit set was above average and the weather leading up to picking time was ideal. The fruit quality was pristine, thanks to the mostly dry conditions.

Tasting Notes:

The 2021 Wadenswil Pinot Noir offers a unique and intriguing bouquet, characteristic of the Wadenswil clone of Pinot Noir. The nose introduces vibrant notes of blood orange and sanguine elements, alongside a heady allure of crushed herbs and cured olives. Hints of licorice, white pepper, and the sweetness of blackberry and stewed strawberry create a harmoniously complex symphony.

On the palate, this wine continues to captivate, showcasing the unique character of the clone through the lens of Trovato Vineyard's inherent terroir. Mulberry takes the lead, joined by the earthy essence of humus and the subtle kick of black pepper. Red apple skin adds a touch of brightness, while sweet yet chewy tannins provide a pleasing texture, all balanced by a tangy acidity that keeps you engaged.
